SERVING IN AGWM MOBILIZATION

Dave and Cheryl served as area directors for Mexico. They lived in Mexico City and were involved in Church Planters Boot Camps and Church Renovation Clinics - which are 3-4 day conferences focusing on training Church Planters in the steps necessary to start a new church and helping Pastors in Church Growth. Both Dave and Cheryl taught in the local Bible school. They led the Youth Group and BGMC programs in their local church. They also visited and preached in other churches in and around Mexico City. They attended numerous conferences and retreats throughout the country where they were frequently the speakers.

With a population of 100 million people, Mexico is the world's largest Spanish-speaking nation. Some 30 million Mexicans live in and around Mexico City, the world's largest metropolis. The city is built on the ruins of Tenochtitlan, originally established some 800 years ago by the Aztecs. Mexico's Spanish culture is a result of 300 years of Spanish colonialism prior to independence in 1823.

The Assemblies of God has a long history of ministry in Mexico. Today, the Fellowship includes about 5,000 churches reaching an estimated 1 million people. Forty-six Bible schools with 100 extension programs are training 2,000 men and women for ministry. Despite the church's growth, great spiritual and social needs remain among the other 99 percent of the population.
